Tanzania 6 Days Kilimanjaro Climb Itinerary

Trip to : Killimanjaro Climb – Machame Route
Nights to spend : 5 Nights / 6 Days
No of people : 1-7 (Sharing)
No of rooms : 01 double/twin room

Exact game drive times are not detailed on the itinerary. Full day game drives with a picnic lunch or morning and evening drives with lunch at the lodge are both options. Please speak with your guide each evening about which option you prefer for the following day. Kindly note park fees are paid in 24 hour increments so the guide will need to enter and exit parks at certain times.

Arrival

6 DAYS KILIMANJARO CLIMB - MACHAME ROUTE

The most beautiful, but Technical, climbing skills required, is now often booked by many - a bit more expensive but worth it for frequent climbers. The climb crossing the breath rain forest gives you an open view of the glacier when you reach the Shira Plateau situated in the middle of the moorlands.

DAY 1: Arusha - Machame Gate {1800m} - Machame camp {3000m}

Arrive to the Machame Gate in a 4WD vehicle, introduction to your guide and porters. Registration is done and thereafter start climb {Hiking /Trekking} with picnic lunch through rain forest for approximately 4 to 5 hrs where you arrive to the Machame Hut. Later afternoon walk up to a little higher altitude is done for acclimatization. Return to Machame Hut for dinner and overnight.

DAY 2: Machame camp {3000m} - Shira camp {3800m}

After breakfast, start climb through short Savannah forest and other vegetation for approximately 4 to 5 hrs, with picnic lunch en route before arriving in the afternoon at the Shira Hut for dinner and overnight.

DAY 3: Shira camp {3800m} - Barranco camp {3950m}

After breakfast a slow walk through semi-glacier and sandy areas with picnic lunch 3 to 4 hrs before arriving at the Barranco Hut for dinner and overnight.

DAY 4: Barranco camp {3950m} - Barafu camp {4600m}

After breakfast, with picnic lunch en-route climb through glaciers for approximately 4 to 5 hours before arriving at the Barafu Hut for dinner and overnight.

DAY 5: Barafu camp {4600m} - Stella Point {5750m} - UHURU PEAK {5895m} – Mweka Camp

An early wake-up call around 01.00hrs for preparation and light breakfast before starting final ascent to the summit i.e. either the Stella Point reached in approximately 5 to 6 hrs and a further ascent to the Uhuru Peak reached in another approx 45minutes. After signing and short rest at Barafu hut descend via the Gilman's Point down to Mweka hut for an hours rest with light breakfast then descent down for dinner and overnight at Mweka camp.

DAY 6: Mweka Camp – Arusha

After breakfast, final descent to Mweka gate, thereafter say Goodbye to your Guide/Porters and connect a private transfer to Arusha

7 Days Kilimanjaro Climb Machame Route

Day 01: Machame Gate to Machame Hut (Full Board)

The climb starts from Machame gate (1830m), we walk through the lush lower slopes of Mt. Kilimanjaro. Slowly gaining altitude while enjoying the diverse flora and fauna of the rain forest, you will arrive to the first Machame Hut, situated at 3000m above sea level

If is a clear day we may get our first closer look at the glaciated dome of Kibo if the evening clouds permit.

Machame Gate to Machame Hut (3,000 m): 6-7 hours walking.

Day 02: Machame Camp to Shira Camp (Full Board)

A shorter day climbing up a steep ridge to reach a small semicircular cliff known as Picnic site, and continue up a gentler ascent through the lower alpine moorland, which is known for beautiful wild alpine flowers. The most spectacular views of Kibo peak can be seen from Shira Camp.

Machame Hut to Shira Camp (3,840m); 4-6 hours walking

Day 03: Shira Camp to Barranco Valley (Full Board)

Today we walk on a gentle ascent and panoramic views. We traverse the southwest side of Kilimanjaro, passing underneath the Lava Tower and the final section of the Western Breach and after hot lunch the bottom of the Lava Tower (4,600 m.) we descend to the bottom of the Great Barranco valley (3,900 m.).

Shira Camp to Barranco valley (3,900 m.): 5-7 hours walking.

Day 04: Barranco Camp to Karanga (Full Board)

A steep climb up the eastern wall leads us just below the Heim Glacier, where we may have some spectacular views of Kilimanjaro. We then take a steep exit up the Great Barranco Wall, which divides us from the southeastern slopes of Kibo, the trail continues down into the alpine desert of the Karanga Valley. This is a short day meant for acclimatization

•Elevation (ft): 13,000ft to 13,100ft •Distance: 5 km •Hiking Time: 4-5 hours Walking

Day 05: Karanga Valley to Barafu Camp (Full Board)

After breakfast, we leave Karanga and hit the junction which connects with the Mweka Trail. After a short break for a hot lunch we take a steep climb out of Karanga and an easy path on compacted scree with wide views through this empty and dry landscape up to Barafu Camp. The two peaks Kibo and Mawenzi can be seen from Barafu Camp. After a hot lunch at the Camp, The remainder of the day is spent resting as we prepare for the final ascent before an early night summit walk.

Karanga Camp to Barafu Camp (4,600 m): 4-5 hours walking.

Day 06: Barafu Camp to Summit to Mweka Camp (Full Board)

Wake up before midnight in the cover of darkness. We begin a steep climb over loose volcanic scree has some well-graded zig-zags and a slow but steady pace will take us to rim of the main crater, Stella Point, at 5,735m. We will rest there for few minutes to enjoy the sunrise over Mawenzi. Those who are still feeling good can continue slowly to make the two hour round trip from here along the crater rim to main peak (5,895 m), which is the highest point in Africa. After a few minutes to appreciate your accomplishment we descend to Barafu is amazingly fast, and we stop at Barafu Camp for some refreshment, we continue to descend to reach Mweka Camp.

Barafu Camp to Summit to Mweka Camp (3100 m): 13-15 hours walking.

Day 07: Descend – Mweka Camp to Mweka Gate to Arusha

A gentle walk takes us down through the rainforest to Mweka gate successful climbers will receive their summit certificates. After lunch we drive back to Arusha and dropped off at your hotel for hot shower, relaxation, dinner and overnight.

Mweka Camp to Mweka Gate: 3-5 hours walking.
