### Tanzania Safari Itinerary

**Safari dates; Jan – March ,June – Dec 21<sup>st</sup> 2022.**

**Rooming: TBA**

Exact game drive times are not detailed on the itinerary. Full day game drives with a picnic lunch or morning and evening drives with lunch at the lodge are both options. Please speak with your guide each evening about which option you prefer for the following day. Kindly note park fees are paid in 24 hour increments so the guide will need to enter and exit parks at certain times.

#### **Day 1: Arrival-Arusha**

Non game-viewing travel time: Aprox **1 hour & 13 mins**, Distance: **49.3km**

You will be met at the International Airport of Kilimanjaro by your guide and our representative. From there, we will take you to Arusha for a briefing a Gran Melia Hotel about your safari highlights tour.

An oasis within Arusha set out on 18 acres of beautiful landscaped coffee and tea plantations. Pure tranquility with spectacular views of Mount Meru. Gran Meliá Arusha offers a unique experience combining the most exciting once-in-a-lifetime safari destination with state-of-the-art conference facilities. Dinner and overnight **Gran Melia** - Bed & Breakfast.

NB – If you arrive into another airport than Kilimanjaro we'll arrange a connection flight to Arusha either on arrival or the following day (at extra cost). From Nairobi is possible road transfer in private or shared vehicles.

#### **Day 2: Arusha to Tarangire**

Non game-viewing travel time: Aprox **2 hours**, Distance: **120 km**

After breakfast we head into the Tarangire National Park for a morning game drive. The drive from Arusha to the park is approximately two hours.

The park runs along the line of the Tarangire River and is mainly made up of low-lying hills on the Great Rift Valley floor. Its natural vegetation mainly consists of Acacia woodland and giant African Baobab trees, with huge swamp areas in the south. Both the river and the swamps act like a magnet for wild animals, during Tanzania's dry season. The Tarangire National Park is reputed to contain some of the largest elephant herds in Africa, ostrich, baboon and many bird and antelope species.

- Early breakfast with packed lunch depart by road for Tarangire N. Park
- Enjoy full day game drive in Tarangire National Park
- Dinner and overnight **Tarangire Maromboi Lodge** - Full Board

#### **Day 3 :Tarangire to Karatu**

Non game-viewing travel time: Aprox **1 hour & 42 mins**, Distance: **99.9 km**

After breakfast; transfer to Karatu at leisure. Activity – visit the local community Iraqw tribe, school visit, and waterfall – picnic lunch. Proceed *Kitena Lodge*.

- Early breakfast with packed lunch by road for Karatu Activity
- Enjoy full day Local community/school visit and waterfalls.
- Dinner and overnight **Kitena Lodge** - Full Board

#### **Day 4: Karatu – Olduvai Gorge – Serengeti**

Non game-viewing travel time: Aprox **2 hour & 4 mins**, Distance: **96.5 km**

After breakfast you start on your way to Serengeti National Park. A picnic lunch will be provided. On the way you will stop at the Oldupai Gorge where anthropologists Louis and Mary Leakey made many significant discoveries, contributing to the theory that human life originated in Africa. After stopping for your picnic lunch on a kopje (rock outcropping) in Serengeti you will continue further into the park and go on a game drive and head to Serengeti Kubukubu Tented Lodge at Central Serengeti.

- Early breakfast with packed lunch by road for Serengeti
- Enjoy Olduvai Gorge visit , and game drive enroute to Serengeti National Park
- Dinner and overnight **Kubukubu Tented Lodge** - Full Board

### **Day 5: Serengeti National Park**

Non game-viewing travel time: Aprox **1 hour & 36 mins**, Distance: **90.4 km**

A full day of game drives around Serengeti , Depending on the time of the year and the migration of the herds you can expect to see wildebeests, lions, elephants, giraffes, zebras, monkeys, baboons, hippos, rhinos, antelopes and many birds and other species.

- Early breakfast with packed lunch by road for Serengeti
- Enjoy full day game drive in Serengeti National Park
- Dinner and overnight **Kubukubu Tented Lodge** – Full Board.

### **Day 6: Serengeti National Park to Ngorongoro Conservation Area**

Non game-viewing travel time: Aprox **1 hour & 33 mins**, Distance: **62.2 km**

Transfer to Ngorongoro Conservation Area along the way. Game drive in Ngorongoro area in the afternoon, arriving Neptune Ngorongoro at approximately 6pm for dinner.

Ngorongoro's wildlife includes lion, hippo, flamingo, rhino and many antelope species.

- Early breakfast with packed lunch by road for Ngorongoro Conservation Area.
- Enjoy full day game drive in Serengeti National Park
- Dinner and overnight **Ngorongoro Serena Lodge**- Full Board

### **Day 7: Ngorongoro Crater - Arusha**

Non game-viewing travel time: Aprox **3 hours & 54 mins**, Distance: **193 km**

Early morning descend to Ngorongoro Crater, the Crater is not only the largest unbroken caldera in the world it is also one of the Seven Wonders of the World. The Ngorongoro Crater is one of the most densely crowded African wildlife areas in the world and is home to an estimated 30,000 animals including some of Tanzania's last remaining black rhino. Supported by a year round water supply and fodder, the Ngorongoro Crater supports a vast variety of animals, which include herds of wildebeest, zebra, buffalo, eland, warthog, hippo, and giant African elephants. . After morning game drive, you will take a break to enjoy your packed lunch at the Hippo Pool Picnic site before continue with your afternoon game drive. And later return to Arusha, (**Optional Visit Kibowa Orphanage en route**) dinner and overnight in **Kigongoni Lodge**.

- Early breakfast with packed lunch by road for Ngorongoro Crater
- Enjoy full day crater tour in Ngorongoro National Park
- Dinner and overnight **Kigongoni Lodge** –Full Board.

### **Day 8: Flight to Kilimanjaro**

Non game-viewing travel time: Approx. **45 mins**, Distance: **40km**

*Flight Kilimanjaro - TBA* After breakfast, transfer to Kilimanjaro time TBA  
Connect to international flight home.
